Eight Indian Americans among finalists to White House Fellows



Washington, DC: At least eight Indian Americans are among the 108 regional finalists to the prestigious White House Fellows for the year 2009-2010.

The list was released by White House on March 3. White House Fellows Program is the most prestigious program for leadership and public in the US. The regional finalists would be interviewed for the final list of about 30 outstanding women and men, who would then be appointed as a White House Fellow for one year by the US President, Barack Obama.

While the White House does not release the names of the regional finalists based on the ethnicity of the successful candidates, the Press Trust of India (PTI) has identified at least eight of them as Indian Americans, based on their names.

These outstanding Indian Americans, who have made it to the list of 108 regional finalists, are Komal Bazaz Smith from Arlington in Virginia; Sudip K. Bose (Chicago); Sreekanth K. Chaguturu (Boston); Amar A. Desai (West-lake Village, Cali-formia); Anish P. Mahajan (Los Angeles); Manish K. Sethi (Brookline, Massachusetts); Minesh Shah (Bronx, New York) and Raj M. Shah (Philadelphia).

Among the alumni of this prestigious fellowship are former Secretary of State Colin Powell, CNN Chief Medical Correspondent Dr. Sanjay Gupta, Travelocity CEO Michelle Peluso, and Dallas Mayor Tom Leppert.
